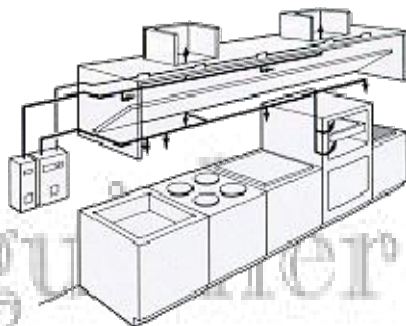

Fire Extinguisher A, B, C's

Know Your

Fire Extinguisher A,B,C's

A fire extinguisher is a storage container for a fire extinguishing agent such as water or chemicals. Fire extinguishers are labeled according to the type of fire they are intended for. Using the wrong type of extinguisher on a fire can make the situation much worse.

Traditionally, fire extinguishers have only been labeled with the letters A, B, C, or D to indicate the type of fire they are to be used on. Recently, pictograms or pictures have come into use. A blue

pictogram or picture on the extinguisher indicates the type of fire it should be used on, and a black picture with a slash through it indicates the type of fire it should not be used on. Fire extinguishers may have the letter indicators, pictograms, or both.

Fire Extinguisher Types:

Type A: Ordinary combustibles, wood, paper, rubber, fabrics and many plastics

Type B: Flammable liquids & gases, gasoline, oils, paint, lacquer and tar

Type C: Fire Involving live electrical equipment

Type D: Combustible metals or combustible metal alloys.

Type K: Fires in cooking appliances that involve combustible cooking media, vegetable and animal fats.
