Full-Metal vs. Plastic Fire Extinguishers

Depending on the manufacturer, did you know fire extinguishers are either plastic, part plastic, or full-metal? We recommend purchasing full-metal fire extinguishers for your home, office, and vehicle. Properly maintained full-metal fire extinguishers from Extinguisher Co. No. 1 can last a lifetime and can be refilled if discharged - *unlike many of the plastic ones*.

With time, temperature changes, and ultraviolet light, the plastic found in fire extinguishers can deteriorate and become brittle which causes the valve to loose pressure **reducing its reliability**. In addition, many plastic fire extinguishers can not be refilled once used or when pressure is lost - requiring you to purchase a replacement extinguisher.

While there are many things you can do to prevent fires from occurring, it is always a good idea to have quality full-metal fire extinguishers from Extinguisher Co. No. 1 on hand should one start.
